Postdoc Union Update



Early in October, the UC Postdoc Union, UAW Local 5810 (uaw5810.org), collectively bargained for improvements to the Postdoctoral Scholars Benefits Plan, including a transgender surgery benefit commensurate with all other UC faculty and staff health plans. In a subsequent state-wide vote, 97% of voting postdocs endorsed this new benefits package. The UAW believes the ongoing struggle for full civil and human rights for everyone - including the LGBTQ

community - cannot be separated from the fight for justice for all workers. The Postdoc Union is working around the country to achieve full equality and has worked to overturn Prop. 8 in California and helped to pass Marriage Equality laws in Washington, New York, and other states. 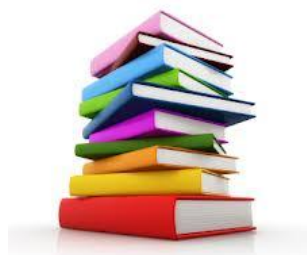
