



Dr. Shaun Travers is a Campus Diversity Officer and Director of the Lesbian Gay Bisexual Transgender Resource Center at the University of California, San Diego. An active representative of the bisexual community, he has presented at Harvard College, the National Conference on Race and Ethnicity, the NASPA Multicultural Institute, and numerous trainings on campuses throughout the country. At UC San Diego he has led the

Undergraduate Diversity Leadership Institute, the Building Communities for Social Justice Practice Institute, Anti-Racist Practice Leadership groups, LEAD Fellows, and the Culturally Competent Management Program through Human Resources. His current practice and leadership involves a deep understanding of intersectionality, power, privilege, oppression and the dynamic tension inherent in university environments. Formerly he has served as Vice President of the congregation at First Lutheran Church San Diego, Chair of the Education Committee for the National Consortium of Lesbian Gay Bisexual Transgender Resource Professionals in Higher Education, and Co-Chair of the Mentorship Committee for the GLBT Knowledge Community at NASPA. Prior to UC San Diego, Shaun coordinated Gender Issues Education Services, including Women's Development Programs and Advocacy Services for victims of sexual violence, at Texas A&M University. He has served on the Board of Directors of Planned Parenthood of the Pacific Southwest, and the Board of Directors of the American Red Cross – Brazos Valley Texas.
