Welcome all UC San Diego Faculty and Staff! The UC San Diego LGBT Resource Center serves our entire community including students, staff, alumni, and our faculty. We are proud to have YOU as a part of our family.

On June 3-9, 2012, four people who work at UC San Diego will be joining a couple thousand cyclists from around the world to ride from San Francisco to Los Angeles and raise money to fight HIV and AIDS in AIDS LifeCycle. Angela Kozakowski, who works at the AVRC (Antiviral Research Center), is riding for the fourth time. For Suzi Harlow (Graduate




Coordinator for Economics) and David Carlos (Information Services in UCSD Hospitals), this will be their second year on the ride. Helen Mout (Science Studies Program Coordinator) is a first time rider. As of 5/25/12, they have collectively raised over \$17,000 to support HIV/AIDS services, research, and advocacy work at the San Francisco AIDS Foundation and Los Angeles Gay and Lesbian Center. There are 35 riders/roadies on team San Diego (http://www.tofighthiv.org/site/TR/AIDSLIFECYCLE11/AIDSLifeCycleCente r?team\_id=8460&pg=team&fr\_id=1440), and probably 50 riders from San Diego altogether. Team San Diego's training rides are open and are organized on Facebook (https://www.facebook.com/ALCSanDiego).
